You do **not** need to be a technology expert to effectively use OutreachCircle.

This OutreachCircle Supporter Kit and its accompanying resources are designed to:

- Introduce League members and Supporters to their League's OutreachCircle
- Maximize current LWV work
- Empower voters and defend democracy

Step 1.

Access OutreachCircle

The OutreachCircle app is **free** for both Apple (iPhone) and Android (Samsung Galaxy, Google Pixel, etc.).

For non-smartphone users, OutreachCircle is also available online. **To access OutreachCircle on your computer**, click on the button below or enter the web address into your web browser.

To access the OutreachCircle on your smartphone, you'll first need to download the app. We can help with that!

If you already have the app, don't need help downloading it onto your phone, or if you only plan on accessing OutreachCircle through your computer, you can skip ahead to Step 2 while we set up smartphone users.

Once you've opened your smartphone's app store, follow the instructions below:

- Search for "OutreachCircle" in the search bar.
 - $^{\circ}$ On both iPhone and Android app stores, the search area is indicated by the \mathbf{Q} icon.
- Select the option to download the OutreachCircle app.
 Remember: the app is 100% free.
 - The app store may ask for your password to confirm your download. If you don't remember your password, follow your phone's instructions on how to reset your password.
- Wait for the download to complete, then open the OutreachCircle app.

Now let's get you set up with an account!



Step 2. Sign in

There are **two** kinds of OutreachCircle account:

- Admin: an account that your League will use to control its OutreachCircle and publish content.
 - There may be more than one Admin per OutreachCircle.
- Supporter: This is your account! Using your Supporter account, you and other League members can interact with League OutreachCircles.
 - As a Supporter, you can follow more than one League's OutreachCircle.

Got it? Awesome! Now let's get your Supporter account set up.



When you first open the OutreachCircle app, you'll see something similar to the image on the right.

First things first, let's get you signed in.

Keep an eye out for the **S**icon.

We'll use it to help show you exactly where to look.

Ready? So are we!

Tap the "Sign In" button.







OutreachCircle will bring up the screen on the right. You have a few different options for signing in.

Selecting Google, Facebook, or Apple will prompt a login popup similar to the ones below.








Worried about privacy? We get it! Remember that if you decide to sign in with Google, for example, you are **not** giving OutreachCircle access to emails. OutreachCircle has a very strict privacy policy.

If you want to sign in using Google, Facebook, or Apple, type in the requested information, follow the prompts to proceed, and skip ahead to Step 3!

If you don't want to sign in using Google, Facebook, or Apple, you can create an account using your email address. Tap **"Continue with Email"** to select that option.





Type in the email address you'd like to use.

OutreachCircle won't spam you with emails, but your League's OutreachCircle might opt to send you alerts when your help is needed on a particular action.

Once you have your email typed in, tap **"Next"** to continue.

Step 3. Find a League




OutreachCircle is a pretty intelligent tool and can tell the difference between first and last names as long as you've entered them correctly in your contacts.


Tap the **"Got it"** button to proceed.

We can tap the tick boxes on the right-hand side to add them to the email. The green icon will show us which contacts have been selected.


If you like, tap the message to edit it. You don't need to type your friend's name; we'll explain the "First Name" part in a minute. Click **"Done"** to continue.
